## SENSHU UNIVERSITY PROFILE

専修大学は1880年に創立され、140年以上の歴史を持つ人文・社会・情報科学系の8学部を有する高等教育機関です(2023年の学生数は17,438人、242人の留学生を含む)。日本語や日本の文化を効果的に学びたいという留学生を広く受け入れるため、1年に4回の日本語・日本事情プログラムを1996年から開講し、世界各国からの参加者を受け入れています。

Founded in 1880, Senshu University is an institution of higher education with a history that spans more than 140 years. It has eight faculties in fields such as humanities, social sciences, and information science (the 2023 student population is 17,438 which includes 242 international students). We offer the Japanese Language and Culture (JLC) Program to international students wanting to effectively learn the Japanese language and deepen their understanding of Japanese culture. Since 1996, this program has been offered four times a year with participants from all over the world.

### About Japanese Language & Culture Program

日本語の授業は月曜日から金曜日の9:00a.m.から12:50p.m.に行われます。  
1コマ50分の授業を4コマ受講します。  
クラスはレベル別に分けられており、自分のレベルにあったクラスで受講できます。

Classes are primarily held from 9:00 a.m. -12:50p.m.  
(four periods composed of four successive 50 minute sessions) Monday through Friday.  
Up to seven different levels of classes will be held according to the abilities of the applicants.

### 🏠 ホームビジット(オプション) / Home Visit [Optional]

はい、12年以上の教育課程を修了していれば参加できます。

We cannot guarantee that any credits earned through this program are transferable, so please inquire with your home university.



Do I have to participate in homestay?



No, the homestay is completely optional.



Can I stay overnight at a hotel or a friend's house during the program period?



Yes, as long as it doesn't affect your attendance or coursework.





## I-House

専修大学国際交流会館

2人部屋が基本の居室は52室。JLCプログラム参加者のほかに、国際交流協定校からの交換留学生や寮内留学参加学生、レジデント・アシスタント(RA)ら計102人が暮らすことが出来る施設です。共有スペースとして、キッチン、ダイニング、ランドリールーム、レクルームや自習室なども利用することができます。キッチンには調理器具や調理家電を完備しており、時には様々な国の料理を囲んでパーティなどが行われます。また、ダイニングやレクルームで専修大学学生と留学生が活発に交流することができます。

The I-House has 52 student rooms (with two students to a room) that can accommodate a total of 102 residents, including not only JLC Program participants, but also international exchange students and Senshu University students living in the dormitory as Resident Partners (RPs) or Resident Assistants (RAs). The dormitory also has shared communal areas such as kitchens, dining space, laundry rooms, study rooms, and a recreation room, all of which are kept clean and well maintained. The kitchen is fully equipped with cooking utensils and appliances, and parties are often held inside the dormitory with food from various countries around the world. All students living in the dorm have many opportunities to enjoy meaningful cross-cultural interactions on a daily basis.

I-Houseにはスタッフが常駐しており、セキュリティも万全です。また、レジデント・アシスタント(RA)も滞在しており、急病の時の対応や日本での生活のサポートをしています。

The I-House has full-time staff and a security office. Senshu University students residing as Resident Assistants (RAs) are also available to provide support during participants' daily life in Japan and in the event of sudden illness.

I-Houseでは、様々な交流を行っています。歓迎会をはじめ、季節のイベント、東京都近郊へのフィールドトリップなど、たくさんのイベントを用意しています。また、専修大学学生のキャンパスアシスタント(CA)とのイベントもあり、様々な日本人学生との交流の機会があります。

The I-House facilitates daily cross-cultural interactions among students. Furthermore, the JLC Program includes welcome parties, seasonal events, excursions to sightseeing spots around Tokyo, and more. These events and excursions are also attended by Senshu University students residing outside of the dormitory as volunteer Campus Assistants (CAs).

国際交流会館にはレジデントパートナー(RP)と呼ばれる専修大学生が居住しています。寮生活のサポートが受けられるほか、共に生活する中で日本語の会話力を高めたり、日本文化に対する理解を深めることができます。留学期間をとおして、国際交流の機会を豊富に提供しています。
