

Full-time (Tenured) Position, Senshu University

- Assigned courses: Specialized subject courses in the Department of Intercultural Communication of the School of International Communication (to be established in 2020) and language skills courses (English).
1. Specialized subject courses (“Topics in English”).
 2. English language skills courses in the Department of Intercultural Communication and for the wider university.
 3. Courses related to culture and society in English-speaking regions (e.g., “Area Studies: North America,” “Area Studies: Europe”).
 4. Courses designed to teach culture and society in multicultural and international environments with a global perspective (e.g., “Cultural Collision and Fusion,” “Contemporary Society and Diversity,” “Colonialism and Contemporary Society”).
- *Specialized subject courses (“Topics in English”) and English language skills courses will be the primary assignment.
- Title and position: Professor, Associate Professor or Lecturer (Full-time)
*Title/position to be determined based on the candidate’s education and academic achievements.
- Starting date: April 1, 2020
- Qualifications:
- 1) Native or near-native speakers of English, or speakers with superior competency in English.
 - 2) Experience in using communicative, task-based and meaning-focused methods and techniques to engage learners with meaningful and comprehensible input for listening and reading, and help learners engage in meaningful output for speaking and writing to improve fluency and accuracy with English.
 - 3) Ability to teach courses listed above in English.
 - 4) Sufficient Japanese skills to carry out work duties as a tenured faculty member.
 - 5) Ph.D. or will have completed all degree requirements of a doctoral program by April 1, 2020. Holders of equivalent educational/research qualifications may also apply

Application deadline: All materials must be received no later than August 30, 2019.

Application materials: 1) Curriculum vitae and list of academic publications.

Both forms should be completed in Japanese.
2) Printouts or copies of at least one and up to three publications.
*During the screening process, you may be requested to submit more academic publications.
3) Abstracts for the above publications in English (200 to 300 words each, printed and double-spaced on A4 paper).
*Not necessary if the publication has an abstract attached.
4) Photocopy of highest degree obtained.
5) A brief statement of your teaching philosophy and ideas about teaching English and teaching in English in Japan (approximately 800 words in English, printed and double-spaced on A4 paper).
6) Cover letter.

Upon registration, applicants will be sent a receipt number via email from the university. The receipt number should be printed on the list of academic publications.
*Receipt of all materials makes your application official.

Selection process: After preliminary screening based on the submitted materials, shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview (to be conducted in both English and Japanese) and teaching demonstration in the latter part of October or early November. Interviewees may be asked to submit a sample syllabus prior to the interview.
